EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES

**The Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education)
(Amendment) Order 1981**

Made - - - 21st January 1981

Coming into Operation 30th January 1981

Whereas—

(1) in pursuance of section 2(2) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965(a) (“the Act”) the Committee constituted under section 1 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration payable to teachers in establishments of further education (within the meaning of the Further Education Regulations 1975(b)) maintained by local education authorities and to other further education teachers on the staff of such authorities (except teachers seconded to bodies which reimburse the employing authorities the amount of their salaries) (“the Committee”) have transmitted to the Secretary of State for Education and Science (“the Secretary of State”) recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of such teachers;

(2) there are in force Orders made under section 2 of the Act with respect to the remuneration of such teachers, namely, the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) Order 1980, the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) Order 1980 and the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1980(c);

(3) it appears to the Secretary of State that effect can most conveniently be given to the recommendations of the Committee by amending the scales and other provisions set out in the document referred to in the said Orders, namely, the document published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office on 21st February 1980 under the title “SCALES OF SALARIES FOR TEACHERS IN ESTABLISHMENTS FOR FURTHER EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES 1979” (“the Document”);

(4) in pursuance of section 2(5) of the Act the Secretary of State has prepared a draft Order (being the draft of this Order) setting out the amendments of the scales and other provisions which, in his opinion, are requisite for giving effect to the recommendations of the Committee; and

(5) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(6) of the Act, has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft Order and the Committee have made no representations with respect thereto.

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in pursuance of sections 2(6), 7(2) and 7(3) of the Act, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) Order 1981.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on 30th January 1981 and shall have effect as from 1st April 1980.

Amendment of Document

2. The scales and other provisions contained in the Document are hereby amended, with effect from 1st April 1980, in the manner following:—

In section 14 (London Area Payment)—

- (1) in paragraph (1), for the sum there mentioned there shall be substituted the sum “£759”;
- (2) in paragraph (2), for the sum there mentioned there shall be substituted the sum “£498”;
- (3) in paragraph (4), for the sum there mentioned there shall be substituted the sum “£213”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends, as regards the London Area Payment, the scales and other provisions relating to the remuneration of teachers in all establishments of further education (within the meaning of the Further Education Regulations 1975) maintained by local education authorities and of other such further education teachers on the staff of such authorities (except teachers seconded to bodies which reimburse the employing authorities the amount of their salaries) set out in a document published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office. The Order gives effect to recommendations agreed by the Committee constituted under the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965 for the consideration of the remuneration of such teachers.

The Order has retrospective effect from 1st April 1980 by virtue of section 7(3) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965.
