**The Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants)
(Amendment) Order 1981***Made* - - - - 7th January 1981*Coming into Operation* 28th January 1981

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 11(vi) and (vii), 20(viii) and (ix), 50(1) and 85(1) of the Diseases of Animals Act 1950(a) and now vested in them (b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order as follows:—

Citation, extent, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order, which may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) (Amendment) Order 1981, shall apply to Great Britain and shall come into operation on 28th January 1981.

(2) In this order “the principal order” means the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978(c).

Amendment of principal order

2.—(1) At the end of Schedule 1 to the principal order (which lists disinfectants approved by the Minister) there shall be added the entries listed in Schedule 1 to this order.

(2) The entries listed in Schedule 2 to this order shall be deleted from Schedule 1 to the principal order.

(3) For Schedule 2 to the principal order (which lists disinfectants subject to transitional provisions) there shall be substituted the provisions of Schedule 3 to this order.

(4) In Article 6(2) of the principal order (which relates to disinfectants subject to transitional provisions) for the words “31st December 1980” there shall be substituted the words “30th June 1981”.

The disinfectants deleted may, however, continue to be used as approved disinfectants until 30 June 1981.
