EDUCATION, SCOTLAND

The Dundee College of Technology (Amendment) Scheme 1981

Made - - - - - 15th May 1981

Coming into Operation 15th May 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 105(1), 116 and 112(2) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf and after—

- (a) preparing a draft scheme to amend the Dundee College of Technology Scheme 1975 (as amended),
- (b) carrying out the procedure specified in section 112(1) of the said Act, and
- (c) no objections or proposed amendments to the draft scheme having been received by him,

the Secretary of State hereby makes the following scheme:—

Citation

1. This scheme may be cited as the Dundee College of Technology (Amendment) Scheme 1981. The principal scheme and this scheme shall be construed as one and may be cited as the Dundee College of Technology Schemes 1975 and 1981.

Interpretation

2. In this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires:

“principal scheme” means the Dundee College of Technology Scheme 1975(b).

Amendment to principal scheme

3. In the principal scheme, for sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 45 the following sub-paragraph shall be substituted:

“(3) The governing body acting jointly with the governing body of the College of Art shall determine the periods of office, not exceeding 4 years, of the appointed members of the Joint Standing Committee. Any appointed member of the said Committee shall, on the expiry of his period of office, be eligible for re-appointment to the said Committee.”
