**The Trustee Savings Banks Act 1976
(Commencement No. 8) Order 1981**

Made- - - - 10th June 1981

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 38(3) and (5) of the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1976(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1976 (Commencement No. 8) Order 1981 and shall come into force on 11th June 1981.

Definitions

2. In this Order:

“the 1969 Act” means the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1969(b);

“the 1976 Act” means the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1976.

Commencement provisions

3. The provisions of the 1976 Act specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this Order (which relate to the matters respectively specified in relation to those provisions in column (2) of the Schedule) shall come into force.

Other provisions

4. The consequential provisions contained in Schedule 2 to this Order shall have effect in connection with the repeals made by the provisions of the 1976 Act which are referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order.

Provisions of the 1976 Act (1)	Subject matter of provisions (2)
Section 36(2) so far as that subsection relates to the following provisions of Schedule 6 of the 1976 Act:—	Repeals
Schedule 6, so far as the entries in that Schedule relate to the 1969 Act, sections 32, 33(2), 34(1), 34(2) (in relation only to the words “Subject to subsections (3) and (5) below,”), 34(7). The 1976 Act, section 12(4).	Repeals

SCHEDULE 2

CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISIONS

In connection with the repeals made by the provisions of the 1976 Act which are brought into force by this Order, sections 34(2) and 35(2) of the 1969 Act shall have effect with the following modifications, that is to say—

- (1) in the case of section 34(2), as if for the words “the receipt” there were substituted the words “A receipt issued under subsection (1) of this section in respect of a payment into the Fund made before 21st November 1979 under section 33 of this Act”; and
- (2) in the case of section 35(2), as if for the words “under section 33 of this Act” there were substituted the words “into the Fund”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 11th June section 36(2) of the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1976 in so far as it relates to the repeal of the provisions of the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1969 and the 1976 Act which are specified in Schedule 1 to the Order.

Certain modifications are made to sections 34(2) and 35(2) of the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1969 and are specified in Schedule 2 of the Order. These modifications are necessary following the repeal by the Order of sections 32, 33(2) and 34(1) of the 1969 Act, provisions which were obsolete after the removal of the obligation for trustee savings banks to invest further deposits in the Fund for the Banks for Savings.
