**The Continental Shelf (Protection of Installations) (Revocation)  
(No. 5) Order 1981**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 2(1) and (3) of the Continental Shelf Act 1964<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Continental Shelf (Protection of Installations) (Revocation) (No 5) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 30th June 1981

2. In the Continental Shelf (Protection of Installations) (No. 3) Order 1981<sup>(c)</sup>, Article 2 and the Schedule are hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order revokes those provisions of the Continental Shelf (Protection of Installations) (No. 3) Order 1981 which create a safety zone. This safety zone is no longer needed, as the installation protected thereby has been removed. The earlier Order also corrected an error in the Continental Shelf (Protection of Installations) Order 1981 (S.I. 1981/29), and is not therefore revoked in its entirety.
