**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE**

**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1981**

*Made*       -       -       -       26th June 1981

*Coming into Operation*       27th July 1981

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 27th July, 1981.

2. Part II of Schedule 1 to the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978(c) shall be amended—

- (a) in Group 3D, in respect of the entry relating to machines for filament winding and tape-laying, by substituting for the letter “C” wherever it appears the letter “A”;
- (b) in Group 3H, in respect of the entry relating to magnetic materials, by substituting for the letter “C” wherever it appears the letter “A”;
- (c) in Group 3I,
  - (i) in respect of the entry relating to fibrous and filamentary materials, and
  - (ii) in respect of the entry relating to lubricating oils and greases, by substituting for the letter “C” wherever it appears the letter “A”.
