**1981 No. 951****ROAD TRAFFIC****The Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment)  
Regulations 1981**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>3rd July 1981</i>

<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st August 1981</i>

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 43(6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in him <sup>(b)</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1981.

2. The Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1976<sup>(c)</sup> shall be further amended so as to have effect in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations.

3. In Schedule 5 (Fees for examinations), in column 2 of the Table in Part I, for “£4.00” substitute “£4.26” and for “£6.70” substitute “£7.10”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations further amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1976 by increasing:—

- (i) the fee for the examination of a motor bicycle (without sidecar) from £4.00 to £4.26; and
- (ii) the fee for the examination of any other motor vehicle to which the Regulations apply from £6.70 to £7.10.
