## EDUCATION, SCOTLAND

**The Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland)  
Amendment Regulations 1981**

<i>Made- - - -</i>	30th June 1981
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	20th July 1981
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	11th August 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 49(3) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 11th August 1981.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations:—

the “principal regulations” means the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Regulations 1978(b) and unless the context otherwise requires “bursary” and “payment period” shall have the meaning assigned to them in the principal regulations.

*Amendment of principal regulations*

3. The principal regulations shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in regulation 8(1)(c)(iii) and the proviso thereto (assessment of full-time further education bursaries) there shall be substituted for the sum of “£310” the sum of “£345”.

(b) in Schedule 1 (assessment of higher school bursaries):—

(i) in paragraph 1 for the Table there specified, there shall be substituted the following Table:—

- (ii) in paragraph 4(2) and paragraph (ii) of the proviso thereto for the sum of "£361" there shall be substituted the sum of "£386";
- (c) in Part 1 of Schedule 2 (assessment of estimated expenditure in relation to full-time further education bursaries):—
- (i) in paragraph 1(5) for the sums of "£10.85" and "£26.25" there shall be substituted respectively the sums of "£11.63" and "£28.10";
  - (ii) in paragraph 1(6) for the sums of "£15.95" and "£26.25" there shall be substituted respectively the sums of "£17.05" and "£28.10";
  - (iii) in paragraph 1(7) for the sum of "£19.20" there shall be substituted the sum of "£21.15";
  - (iv) in paragraph 1(8) for the sum of "£8.55" there shall be substituted the sum of "£9.15";
  - (v) in paragraph 1(10) for the Table there specified, there shall be substituted the following Table:—

- (d) in Part 2 of Schedule 2 (assessment of contribution in relation to full-time further education bursaries):—
- (i) in paragraph 4(3)(a) for the sum of "£361" there shall be substituted the sum of "£386";
  - (ii) in paragraph 4(3)(b) for the sum of "£765" there shall be substituted the sum of "£845";
  - (iii) in paragraph 6(a) for the sum of "£2931", in each place where it occurs, there shall be substituted the sum of "£3196";

(iv) for sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 6 there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—

“(b) in the assessment of a category B bursary—

- (i) if the balance of the income of the parents or, as the case may be, the person legally liable to maintain the holder is not less than £6600 and not more than £8300, the contribution shall be £20 with the addition of £1 for every complete £7 by which the balance of income exceeds £6600;
- (ii) if the balance of that income is more than £8300 but not more than £13,200 the contribution shall be £262 with the addition of £1 for every complete £8 by which the balance of income exceeds £8300;
- (iii) if the balance of that income is more than £13,200 the contribution shall be £874 with the addition of £1 for every complete £13 by which the balance of income exceeds £13,200

reduced in each case, in respect of each child of the parent (other than the student) who is wholly or mainly dependent on him, by £70 or, if such child holds a category B bursary or a grant for a degree or equivalent level course, by £195.”;

(v) for sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 6 there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—

“(c) in the assessment of a category B bursary—

- (i) if the balance of the income of the spouse is not less than £5100 and not more than £8300 the contribution shall be £10 with the addition of £1 for every complete £5 by which the balance of income exceeds £5100; and
- (ii) if the balance of that income is more than £8300 the contribution shall be £650 with the addition of £1 for every complete £10 by which the balance of income exceeds £8300

reduced in each case, in respect of each child of the spouse who is wholly or mainly dependent on him, by £70.”

*Transitional provision*

4. Notwithstanding these regulations, the provisions of the principal regulations amended in regulation 3 above shall apply, as in force prior to being so amended, for the purposes of regulation 9 of the principal regulations, in relation to any payment period expiring prior to or current at the date of coming into operation of these regulations.
