The Valuation (Postponement of Revaluation) (Scotland) Order 1982

Made	25th June 1982
Laid before Parliament	6th July 1982
Coming into Operation	29th July 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 37(3) and sub-paragraph (i) of the proviso to section 1(3)(a), as read with section 35(2), of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Valuation (Postponement of Revaluation) (Scotland) Order 1982, and shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is approved by resolution of each House of Parliament.
- 2. In section 37(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1975, in the definition of "year of revaluation", for the reference to "the year 1978-79" there shall be substituted a reference to "the year 1985-86".
 - 3. The Valuation (Scotland) Order 1982(b) is hereby revoked.

This order postpones the next year of revaluation to 1985–86, and in consequence revokes the Valuation (Scotland) Order 1982, which provided that the quinquennial revaluation due in 1983–84 should exclude domestic premises.
