BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**The Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) (Amendment) Order 1982**

In pursuance of section 18(1)(e) and (2) and section 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 (a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) (Amendment) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 27th September 1982.

2. In paragraph (a) of the proviso to Article 2 of the Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) Order 1981 (b) (maximum fee which may be determined by the Board as payable on an application for registration of a scheme where the total value of the tickets or chances which may lawfully be sold in each lottery under the scheme does not exceed £10,000) for the reference to the sum of £40 there shall be substituted a reference to the sum of £50.

3. In paragraph (a) of the proviso to Article 3 of the Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) Order 1981 (maximum further fee which may be determined by the Board as payable, if more than one lottery is to be promoted under a registered scheme, for each lottery promoted under that scheme where the total value of the tickets or chances which may be sold in the lottery does not exceed £10,000) for the reference to the sum of £10 there shall be substituted a reference to the sum of £15.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Lotteries (Gaming Board Fees) Order 1981 by increasing the maximum fees which the Gaming Board may, under the provisions of that Order, determine to be payable under paragraph 7(1) of Schedule 2 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 in connection with the registration of certain lottery schemes and with the lotteries promoted under those schemes. The lottery schemes in respect of which this Order increases the fee on an application for registration and the further fee for each lottery promoted under the scheme are those where the total value of the tickets or chances which may be lawfully sold in each lottery under the scheme does not exceed £10,000.
