**The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment)
(No. 2) Regulations 1982**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	16th August 1982
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	27th August 1982
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	27th September 1982

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 119, 120(1) and 124 of the Road Traffic Act 1972^(a), and now vested in him^(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 27th September 1982.

2. Nothing in Regulations 4, 5 or 6 of these Regulations shall apply where an application—

- (i) for a licence (full, provisional, duplicate or exchange),
- (ii) for an appointment for a test,

was received before 27th September 1982.

3. The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977^(c) shall be further amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations.

4. In Regulation 8 (Fees for licences) for the words “£4.60” and “£2.30” there shall be substituted respectively the words “£5” and “£2.50”.

5. In Regulation 14 (Lost, defaced and exchanged licences)—

- (a) in paragraph (1), for the words “£1.15” there shall be substituted the words “£1.25”; and
- (b) in paragraph (3), for the words “£1.15” there shall be substituted the words “£1.25”.

6. In Regulation 23 (Fees for tests) for the words “£44” there shall be substituted the words “£59.50”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977, as amended, so as to increase the fees payable on the issue of hgv drivers' licences and the fee payable by a person who applies for a heavy goods vehicle driving test—

- (i) the fee for a full hgv drivers' licence is increased from £4.60 to £5 and the fee for a provisional hgv drivers' licence from £2.30 to £2.50 (Regulation 4);
- (ii) the fee for a duplicate or exchange hgv drivers' licence is increased from £1.15 to £1.25 (Regulation 5);
- (iii) the fee payable by a person who applies for a heavy goods vehicle driving test is increased from £44 to £59.50 (Regulation 6).
