1. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (Amendment) Act 1980 (Commencement) Order 1982.

2. Sections 2 and 3 of the Licensing (Amendment) Act 1980 shall come into force on 1st October 1982.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 1st October 1982 sections 2 and 3 of the Licensing (Amendment) Act 1980, which amend the provisions of the Licensing Act 1964 (c. 26) relating to special hours certificates and confer rights of appeal against certain decisions of licensing justices or magistrates' courts concerning such certificates.

The remaining provisions of the 1980 Act came into force on 17th July 1980 when the Act was passed.
