The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 5(1) and 20(1) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967^(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) (Variation) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1982.

Variation of principal order

2. The Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) Order 1981^(b) is varied by substituting for Parts VI and VII of Schedule 1 to that order the following Parts:—

“PART VI

The waters bounded by a line beginning at a point on the southwest coast of England in 5°00' West longitude; thence due south to 49°30' North latitude; thence due west to 7°00' West longitude; thence due north to 50°00' North latitude; thence due east to a point on the southwest coast of England in 50°00' North latitude.

PART VII

The waters bounded by a line beginning at a point on the southwest coast of England in 50°00' North latitude; thence due west to 7°00' West longitude; thence due north to 50°30' North latitude; thence due east to a point on the southwest coast of England in 50°30' North latitude."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order varies the Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) Order 1981 ("the principal order") by substituting an amended text for Parts VI and VII of Schedule 1 to that order. These Parts specify two areas of sea adjacent to the coast of Cornwall in which, by virtue of article 4(f) or, as the case may be, (g) of the principal order, the use of a purse seine net, or of a trawl net having anywhere meshes below the minimum size specified by article 4(f) or (g), is prohibited when fishing for mackerel between 1st March and 31st March 1982.
