**The Pedlars' Certificates (Variation of Fee) (Scotland)
Order 1982**

Made - - - - - 8th February 1982

Laid before Parliament 25th February 1982

Coming into Operation 12th April 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 42(2) of, and paragraph 4A of Part II of Schedule 4 to, the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order, which applies to Scotland only, may be cited as the Pedlars' Certificates (Variation of Fee) (Scotland) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 12th April 1982.

2. In section 5 of the Pedlars Act 1871(b) (Grant of certificate), in regulation (3), for the words "five shillings"(c) there shall be substituted the words "nine pounds".
