The Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Revocation of Election Scheme) Rules 1982 Approval Instrument 1982

Whereas the Central Midwives Board for Scotland have, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 6 of the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Reconstitution) Order 1952 (a) made the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Revocation of Election Scheme) Rules 1982 revoking the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Election Scheme) Rules 1952 which Rules last mentioned were approved by the Secretary of State by the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Election Scheme) Rules 1952 Approval Instrument 1952 (b) and have submitted the said Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Revocation of Election Scheme) Rules 1982 to the Secretary of State for his approval: and whereas the said Rules have in terms of section 34(1) of the Midwives (Scotland) Act 1951 (c) been communicated to the Executive Committee of the General Medical Council:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 34 of the said Act and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I do hereby approve the said Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Revocation of Election Scheme) Rules 1982 in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

This instrument may be cited as the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Revocation of Election Scheme) Rules 1982 Approval Instrument 1982 and shall come into operation on the 31st day of December 1982.
