## EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES

**The Training of Teachers (Revocation) Regulations 1982**

*Made* - - - 15th April 1982

*Laid before Parliament* 27th April 1982

*Coming into Operation* 1st June 1982

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(a) of the Education Act 1962(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Training of Teachers (Revocation) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1982.
2. The Training of Teachers Regulations 1967(b), so far as not previously revoked, are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations revoke the Training of Teachers Regulations 1967.

Regulation 34 of those Regulations (the only provision not previously revoked) authorises the Secretary of State to pay grants to persons undergoing training as teachers. Such persons now qualify for mandatory awards under regulations made under section 1 of the Education Act 1962 and the power conferred by regulation 34 is no longer exercised.
