The Borough of Rhuddlan (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1982

Made - - - - - *26th April 1982*

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 2

Whereas in pursuance of section 58(1) of the Local Government Act 1972^(a) the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales on 10th November 1981 submitted proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the Borough of Rhuddlan:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 58(2) and 67 of the said Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Rhuddlan (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1982.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 5th May 1983 except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that day the said Order shall come into operation on 10th October 1982.

3.—(1) The existing wards of the Borough of Rhuddlan shall be abolished and the said Borough shall be divided into sixteen wards which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and each such ward shall comprise the existing areas specified in column 2 of that Schedule opposite to the name of the ward as given in the said column 1, except that the areas of the Meliden, Prestatyn Central, Prestatyn East, Prestatyn North, Prestatyn South West, Rhyl East, Rhyl South, Rhyl South East, Rhyl South West, Rhyl West, St. Asaph East and St. Asaph West wards are the areas demarcated by green lines on the boundary map referred to in the Rhuddlan (Communities) Order 1982^(b) and designated on that map by reference to the names of the wards of the Communities of Prestatyn, Rhyl and St. Asaph as set out in column (2) of Schedule 2 to that Order.

(2) The number of councillors to be elected for each such ward shall be the number specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order opposite to the name of the ward as given in column 1 of that Schedule.

4. The ordinary elections of all councillors for the Borough of Rhuddlan shall be held simultaneously on the ordinary day of election of non-metropolitan district councillors in 1983 and every fourth year thereafter.
