The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7(1) of the Administration of Justice Act 1965(a), and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Supreme Court Funds (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1982.

2. In Rule 35(1) of the Supreme Court Funds Rules 1975(b), for the words “14 per cent.” there shall be substituted the words “13 per cent.”.
