## BOATS AND METHODS OF FISHING

**The Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing  
Methods) (Variation) (No. 3) Order 1982**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	28th June 1982
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	28th June 1982
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	29th June 1982

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 5(1), 15(3) and 20(1) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) (Variation) (No. 3) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 29th June 1982.

*Variation of the Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) Order 1981*

2. The Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) Order 1981(b) shall be further varied—

(a) by inserting after article 3 thereof the following article:—

*“Prohibition of fishing for herring*

3A. There is hereby prohibited the fishing by any fishing boat for herring (*Clupea harengus*) from 15th August 1982 to 30th September 1982 inclusive in the area of sea specified in Schedule 3.”;

(b) by inserting after Schedule 2 thereto the following Schedule:—

## "SCHEDULE 3

## Article 3A

The waters bounded by a line beginning at the Butt of Lewis; thence in an easterly direction to Cape Wrath; thence in a northerly direction to a point at latitude  $58^{\circ}55'$  North and longitude  $05^{\circ}00'$  West; thence in a westerly direction to a point at latitude  $58^{\circ}55'$  North and longitude  $07^{\circ}10'$  West; thence in a south-westerly direction to a point at latitude  $58^{\circ}20'$  North and longitude  $08^{\circ}20'$  West; thence in a southerly direction to a point at latitude  $57^{\circ}40'$  North and longitude  $08^{\circ}20'$  West; thence due east to the Hebrides; thence in an easterly direction along the west coast of the Hebrides to a point at latitude  $57^{\circ}40.6'$  North and longitude  $7^{\circ}20.65'$  West; thence along a line drawn  $035^{\circ}$  True to a point at latitude  $57^{\circ}50.05'$  North and longitude  $7^{\circ}8.1'$  West; thence in a northerly direction along the west coast of the Hebrides to the point of beginning.";

- (c) by substituting the date "30th September 1982" for the date mentioned in article 6 thereof (which specifies the date on which the order shall cease to have effect).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order extends the duration of the Specified Sea Fish (Prohibition of Fishing and of Fishing Methods) Order 1981 from 30th June 1982 until 30th September 1982 and further varies that order by prohibiting the fishing for herring between 15th August and 30th September 1982 in a specified area of sea round the Hebrides.
