## PILOTAGE

**The Pilotage Commission (Additional Function) Order 1982***Laid before Parliament in draft**Made - - - -*

29th June 1982

*Coming into operation*

5th July 1982

The Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 4(2) and (3) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, a draft of which has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament as required by section 49(3) of that Act:

1. This Order may be cited as the Pilotage Commission (Additional Function) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 5th July 1982.
2. There is hereby conferred on the Pilotage Commission the function of making schemes under which payments may be made by the Commission for the purpose of compensating pilots and their assistants for loss of employment or reductions in earnings suffered by them in consequence of—
  - (a) changes in the organisation of pilotage services, including the introduction of reduced manning levels;
  - (b) the granting of pilotage certificates (whether to nationals of the United Kingdom or to nationals of other Member States of the European Economic Community); or
  - (c) any reduction in the number of ships entering pilotage districts in the United Kingdom.
