## LICENCES AND LICENSING

**The Billiard Licensing Fees Order 1982**

<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>28th August 1982</i>

In pursuance of section 10(4) of the Gaming Act 1845 (a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Billiard Licensing Fees Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 28th August 1982.

2. The fee which under section 10(4) of the Gaming Act 1845 may be charged in respect of the grant or transfer of a billiard licence shall be £8.50.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order provides the fee which may be charged by justices' clerks in respect of the grant or transfer of a billiard licence under section 10 of the Gaming Act 1845, as substituted by the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1982. Under that section as originally enacted the fee for the grant or transfer of a billiard licence was 30p.
