1982 No. 995**CORONERS****The Coroners' Records (Fees for Copies) Rules 1982***Made* - - - - - 20th July 1982*Coming into Operation* 1st September 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 29(2) of the Coroners (Amendment) Act 1926(a), I hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Coroners' Records (Fees for Copies) Rules 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1982.

2. The fees payable to coroners or other persons for furnishing copies, other than photographic copies, of inquisitions or other documents in their custody relating to an inquest shall be as follows:—

- (i) for a copy which does not exceed 5 folios of 72 words each, £2.60;
- (ii) for a copy which exceeds 5 but does not exceed 20 folios of 72 words each, £5.50;
- (iii) for a copy which exceeds 20 folios of 72 words each, £5.50 for the first 20 such folios and 30p for each such folio or part thereof thereafter:

Provided that, where a coroner or other person furnishing a copy as mentioned in this Rule is satisfied that the person to whom the copy is being furnished is within Rule 16(2) of the Coroners Rules 1953(b) and by reason of his financial circumstances ought to be furnished with the copy at a lower rate, he shall fix such lower rate as may be appropriate to the circumstances of that person.

3. The fee payable to a coroner or other person for furnishing a photographic copy of an inquisition or other document in his custody shall be 55p for each photographic sheet.

4. The Coroners' Records (Fees for Copies) Rules 1981(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules replace the Coroners' Records (Fees for Copies) Rules 1981. They increase the fee payable to a coroner or other person for furnishing a copy of an inquisition or other document in his custody relating to an inquest. The figures £2.60, £5.50, 30p and 55p referred to in the Rules were formerly £2.30, £5, 25p and 50p respectively.
