NATIONAL DEBT

**The National Savings Stock Register (Amendment)
Regulations 1983**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	26th July 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	4th August 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st September 1983

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 3 of the National Debt Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, in conjunction, so far as the Regulations relate to the National Debt Commissioners, with those Commissioners, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Savings Stock Register (Amendment) Regulations 1983, and shall come into operation on 1st September 1983.

2. The National Savings Stock Register Regulations 1976(b) shall be amended in Regulation 7(1) by substituting for the words “£5,000” the words “£10,000”.
