Payments to Redundant Churches Fund Order 1983

<i>Made (Approved by the General Synod)</i>	8th November 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	16th November 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st April 1984

We, the Church Commissioners for England, in exercise of the powers conferred on us by section 53(1) of the Pastoral Measure 1983(a) do hereby order as follows:—

1. The maximum amount to be paid to the Redundant Churches Fund by the Church Commissioners during the five year period 1 April 1984 to 31 March 1989 shall not exceed £3,200,000.
2. The maximum amount of the payments which may be made to the said Fund under section 52(1)(a) of the said Measure out of the one-third of the net proceeds of sale and premiums shall be £1,000,000 and such payments shall be applied towards the £3,200,000 referred to in paragraph 1.
3. Subject to paragraph 4 hereof the balance of the said amount of £3,200,000 shall be paid by way of grants made to the Redundant Churches Fund by the Church Commissioners under section 44(10) of the said Measure out of their General Fund.
4. Payments on account of the said £3,200,000 shall be made to the said Fund only when the Church Commissioners are satisfied that (1) the Fund is in need of further money and (2) any such payment shall amount to two-fifths of the sum then to be paid to the Fund, the remaining three-fifths being paid to the Fund out of moneys provided by Parliament.

5. This Order may be cited as the Payments to Redundant Churches Fund Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 1 April 1984.
