**The Agriculture and Horticulture Development (Amendment)
(No. 3) Regulations 1983**

Made - - - - - *29th November 1983*

Laid before Parliament *30th November 1983*

Coming into Operation *1st December 1983*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly, being Ministers designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(a) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Economic Community(b), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the said section 2(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agriculture and Horticulture Development (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1983.

Application

2. These regulations (except the proviso to regulation 6 below) shall not apply in relation to—

- (a) any work, facility or transaction included in an application received by the appropriate Minister before 1st December 1983 for approval of a development plan or for a variation of a development plan approved for the purposes of the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations 1980(c) (hereinafter called “the principal regulations”); or
- (b) any claim for grant towards expenditure incurred for the purposes of those regulations before 1st December 1983.

Amendment of principal regulations

3. The principal regulations shall be further amended in accordance with regulations 4 to 6 of these regulations.

4. In regulation 2(1) thereof (interpretation) there shall be inserted immediately after the definition of "forestry income" the following definition—

"‘glasshouse’ means a fixed or mobile structure, used for the production of horticultural produce for sale, which is mounted on durable foundations, is not less than 1.67 metres high at the ridge, and of which more than half the total area of the sides, ends and roof is of glass or such other translucent material as will give a durability and transparency similar to that of glass;".

5. In regulation 8 thereof (amounts of grant under regulation 7(1))—

- (a) in paragraph (1) for the words "paragraphs 1 to 20 and 22" there shall be substituted the words "paragraphs 1 to 19 and 21";
- (b) in paragraph (4) for the words "paragraphs 1 to 20" there shall be substituted the words "paragraphs 1 to 19";
- (c) in paragraph (5) for the words "paragraphs 1, 4 to 13 and 21" there shall be substituted the words "paragraphs 1, 4 to 13 and 20";
- (d) in paragraph (6) for the words "paragraphs 1 to 13, 14(i), 15, 19 and 21" there shall be substituted the words "paragraphs 1 to 13, 14(i), 15, 18 and 20".

6. The Schedule to these regulations shall be substituted for the Schedule to the principal regulations (eligible works, facilities and transactions and rates of grant)

Provided that such substitution shall not affect the operation of the principal regulations in relation to any work, facility or transaction included in an application received by the appropriate Minister before 1st December 1983 for approval of a development plan or for a variation of a development plan approved for the purposes of the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations 1980 or in relation to expenditure incurred before 1st December 1983.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Agriculture and Horticulture Development Regulations 1980 (implementing Council Directive No. 72/159/EEC (OJ No. L 96, 23.4.72, p. 1 (OJ/SE 1972 (II) p. 324)) on the modernisation of farms and Council Directive 75/268/EEC (OJ No. L 128, 19.5.75, p. 1) on mountain and hill-farming and farming in certain less-favoured areas.

The regulations substitute a new Schedule of items of eligible works, facilities and transactions and rates of grant for the existing Schedule to the principal regulations in relation to any work, facility or transaction which is included in an application for a development plan received on or after 1st December 1983 and to claims for grants towards expenditure incurred on or after that date. The new Schedule consolidates the previous Schedule with some amendments. An increased rate of grant is introduced in relation to the replacement, alteration, etc. of heated glasshouses in a horticultural production business (paragraph 2(iii) of the Schedule) and in relation to the provision etc. of hedges, walls and shelter belts in less-favoured areas (paragraphs 10(i) and 11 of the Schedule).

Grant is no longer available in relation to—

- (a) the provision etc. of permanent buildings, bulk dry stores or silos for the drying or storing of grain unless these are designed and intended solely for grain for consumption by livestock kept on the land on which the relevant agricultural business is run;
- (b) plant or equipment designed and intended for the production, cultivation, harvesting or storage of horticultural produce in a horticultural production business (except glasshouse heating systems including boilers);
- (c) the provision etc. of plant or machinery for agricultural purposes.

The regulations also make it clear that grant is not available for hedge removal (paragraph 7(i) of the Schedule).

Consequential amendments are made to regulation 8 of the principal regulations, and a definition of "glasshouse" is introduced into regulation 2(1) of those regulations (interpretation).
