The Landlord and Tenant Act 1954 (Appropriate Multiplier) **Order 1984**

Made -11th December 1984 20th December 1984 Laid before Parliament 7th May 1985 Coming into Operation

The Secretary of State for the Environment, as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 37(8) of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954 (Appropriate Multiplier) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 7th May 1985.
- 2. The appropriate multiplier for the purposes of paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 37(2)(b) of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954 shall be 3.
- 3. The previous instrument made in the exercise of the above-mentioned powers and known as the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954 (Appropriate Multiplier) Regulations 1981(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases, from 2¼ to 3, the appropriate multiplier to be used in calculating the amount of compensation to which a tenant may be entitled, under Part II of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954, where an order for a new tenancy is precluded on certain grounds. The amount of compensation is arrived at by multiplying either the rateable value of the holding or twice the rateable value of the holding, as the case may be, by the figure prescribed. The previous multiplier was prescribed by S.I. 1981/69, which is revoked by the Order.

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
