# **BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**

# The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1984

Made - - - 1st March 1984

Laid before Parliament 9th March 1984

Coming into Operation 30th April 1984

In pursuance of sections 18(1) and 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1984.
  - (2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.
- 2. Paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of section 16(3) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(b) (conditions on which the provision of amusements is permitted in certain commercial entertainments) shall have effect as if—
  - (a) in paragraph (a), for the sum of 25p there were substituted the sum of 30p;
  - (b) in paragraph (b), for the sum of £12.50 there were substituted the sum of £15; and
  - (c) in paragraph (c), for the sum of 25p there were substituted the sum of 30p.
- 3. The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1982(c) is hereby revoked.

- (c) to be offered as a money prize,

in amusements provided at certain fairs and other commercial entertainments under section 16 of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976.
