## BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

**The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits)  
 (Scotland) Order 1984**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>29th March 1984</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>9th April 1984</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>30th April 1984</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 18(1) and 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) (Scotland) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1984.

(2) This order shall extend to Scotland only.

2. Paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of section 16(3) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(b) (conditions on which the provision of amusements is permitted at certain commercial entertainments) shall have effect as if—

- (a) in paragraph (a), for the sum of 25p there were substituted the sum of 30p;
- (b) in paragraph (b), for the sum of £12.50 there were substituted the sum of £15; and
- (c) in paragraph (c), for the sum of 25p there were substituted the sum of 30p.

3. The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) (Scotland) Order 1982(c) is hereby revoked.

- (b) to be taken by way of the sale of chances; and
- (c) to be offered as a money prize,

in amusements provided at certain fairs and other commercial entertainments under section 16 of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976.
