LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES
**Local Authorities (Expenditure Powers)
(Designation of Local Enactments) Order 1984**
Made - - - - *29th March 1984*

The Secretary of State for the Environment in relation to England, and the Secretary of State for Wales in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1(2)(c) and (5) of the Local Authorities (Expenditure Powers) Act 1983(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with the authorities on whom powers are conferred by the enactments designated by this order, hereby make the following order:—

Title

1. This order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Expenditure Powers) (Designation of Local Enactments) Order 1984.

Designation of Local Enactments

2. The following enactments, being enactments contained in local Acts are hereby designated for the purposes of section 1 of the Local Authorities (Expenditure Powers) Act 1983:—

- (a) section 78 of the London County Council (General Powers) Act 1957(b),
- (b) sections 12, 101 and 102 of the Durham County Council Act 1963(c),
- (c) section 8 of the Flintshire County Council Act 1970(d),
- (d) sections 10 and 11 of the North Riding County Council Act 1970(e),
- (e) Part III of the County of South Glamorgan Act 1976(f), and
- (f) sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the West Yorkshire Act 1980(g).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972 (c. 70) enables a local authority to spend an amount not exceeding the product of a 2p rate in the interest of their area or its inhabitants for purposes for which they are not empowered under any other enactment to do so.

Section 1 of the Local Authorities (Expenditure Powers) Act 1983 provides that any local enactment which is designated under that section is not to be regarded as restricting the powers conferred upon the authority by section 137. Section 1(5) provides that an order designating any such enactment may be expressed to have effect from the beginning of the financial year in which it is made.

This order designates the local enactments referred to in article 2 for the purposes of section 1. The order has effect from 1st April 1983, being the beginning of the financial year in which it is made.
