

1984 No. 571**REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE****The European Assembly Elections (Returning Officers) (England and Wales) Order 1984**

Made - - - - 16th April 1984

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1(2)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph 4(1) of Schedule 1 to, and section 9(2) of, the European Assembly Elections Act 1978(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the European Assembly Elections (Returning Officers) (England and Wales) Order 1984.

(2) This Order shall come into operation at the first general election of representatives to the Assembly of the European Communities held after this Order is made, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to that election this Order shall come into operation forthwith.

(3) In this Order—

(a) references to parliamentary constituencies are references to the parliamentary constituencies in England and Wales established by the Parliamentary Constituencies (England) Order 1983(b) and the Parliamentary Constituencies (Wales) Order 1983(c); and

(b) references to European Assembly constituencies are references to the European Assembly constituencies established by the European Assembly Constituencies (England) Order 1984(d) and the European Assembly Constituencies (Wales) Order 1984(e).

2. In England and Wales, the returning officer for an European Assembly election in the European Assembly constituency specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be the returning officer for a parliamentary election for the parliamentary constituency specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.

3. The European Assembly Elections (Returning Officers) (England and Wales) Order 1979(a) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates the parliamentary constituencies whose returning officers at parliamentary elections are to be returning officers at European Assembly elections in England and Wales (Article 2). The European Assembly constituencies for which the returning officers will act are those established by the European Assembly Constituencies (England) Order 1984 and the European Assembly Constituencies (Wales) Order 1984. This Order does not come into full operation until the first general election of representatives to the European Assembly after this Order is made (Article 1(2)). At that time the European Assembly constituencies established by the Orders referred to above also come into full operation and the Order by which returning officers are at present designated is revoked (Article 3).
