**The Ipswich–Newmarket–Cambridge–St Neots–Bedford–
Northampton–Weedon Trunk Road (Bromham Bypass)
(Revocation) Order 1984**

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act 1980 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The Ipswich–Newmarket–Cambridge–St Neots–Bedford–Northampton–Weedon Trunk Road (Bromham Bypass) Order 1964 (c) is hereby revoked.
2. This order shall come into operation on 14th May 1984 and may be cited as the Ipswich–Newmarket–Cambridge–St Neots–Bedford–Northampton–Weedon Trunk Road (Bromham Bypass) (Revocation) Order 1984.
