The Legal Advice and Assistance (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations  
1984

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 2A and 20 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 27th May 1984.

2. In the Legal Advice and Assistance Regulations (No. 2) 1980(b)—

(a) paragraph (3)(c) of regulation 17; and

(b) in regulation 20, the words “or it is approved under paragraph (3)(c) of regulation 17 above”,

shall be omitted.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Legal Advice and Assistance Regulations (No. 2) 1980, revoking the power to grant assistance by way of representation under section 2A of the Legal Aid Act 1974 to parents or guardians of children who are the subject of care proceedings under the Children and Young Persons Act 1969 (c. 54), in anticipation of the introduction of legal aid under section 28(6A) of the Legal Aid Act 1974 for such parents or guardians on 27th May 1984 section 28(6A) was inserted by section 65(b) of the Children Act 1975 (c. 72).
