1985 No. 1098**PLANT BREEDERS' RIGHTS****The Plant Breeders' Rights (Applications in Designated Countries) (Variation) Order 1985***Made* - - - - - 10th July 1985*Coming into Operation* 16th August 1985

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland, the Secretary of State for Wales and the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by paragraph 2(7) of Part I of Schedule 2 to the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), as extended to Northern Ireland(b) and now vested in them(c) and the said Minister and the Secretary of State, acting jointly, in exercise of the said powers as extended to the Isle of Man(d), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Plant Breeders' Rights (Applications in Designated Countries) (Variation) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 16th August 1985.

Variation of principal order

2. The Plant Breeders' Rights (Applications in Designated Countries) Order 1982(e) is hereby varied by the addition of Hungary and Japan to the list of countries set out in Article 3 of that order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Paragraph 2 of Part I of Schedule 2 to the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964 enables an application for a grant of plant breeders' rights, made in a country to which that paragraph applies, to be treated as if made in the United Kingdom. The countries to which that paragraph applies are those listed in Article 3 of the Plant Breeders' Rights (Applications in Designated Countries) Order 1982 and this order varies the 1982 Order by adding Hungary and Japan to such list of countries (Article 2).
