1985 No. 1293**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE****The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2)
Order 1985**

Made - - - 12th August 1985

Coming into Operation 12th August 1985

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1985 and shall come into operation forthwith.

2. Group 3E of Part II of Schedule 1 to the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1985 (c) shall be further amended as follows:

- (a) in heads (1) to (5) of entry IL1416 (Ships, surface-effect vehicles, water-screw propellers, and specially designed components), for the letter “S” where it occurs opposite the goods listed therein, there shall in every case be substituted the letters “S,I”;
- (b) after head (5A) of the same entry there shall be added the following head:
“(5B) Ships not elsewhere specified in this Part of this Schedule having an overall length of not less than 7.5 metres, including inflatable craft in an inflated or uninflated state, except sail boats, lightvessels, fire floats and dredgersI”.
