**The West Yorkshire Residuary Body (Appointed Day)
Order 1985***Made* - - - - 14th August 1985

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 57(6) of the Local Government Act 1985(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the West Yorkshire Residuary Body (Appointed Day) Order 1985.
2. The day appointed for the establishment of the West Yorkshire Residuary Body is 22nd August 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Local Government Act 1985 abolishes the metropolitan county councils on 1st April 1986.

Section 57 provides for the establishment, in relation to each county, of a body (to be called a “Residuary Body”) to discharge such residuary functions of those councils as are not transferred to other bodies. This order appoints 22nd August 1985 as the day on which the body is to be established for the metropolitan county of West Yorkshire.
