The Commissioners of Customs and Excise, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 13 of the Customs and Excise Duties (General Reliefs) Act 1979(a) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duty (Personal Reliefs) (No. 1) Order 1968 (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1985.

2.—(1) Paragraph (a) of Schedule 1 to the Customs Duty (Personal Reliefs) (No. 1) Order 1968(b) shall be amended as follows.

(2) In sub-paragraph (2) for the words “4 litres” there shall be substituted the words “5 litres”.

(3) In sub-paragraph (4) for the words “£163” there shall be substituted the words “£207”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

With effect from 1st October 1985, this Order increases from 4 to 5 litres the still table wine duty free allowance, and from £163 to £207 the "other goods" duty free allowance, for intra-Community travellers.

This puts into effect Council Directive 85/348/EEC (O.J. No. L183, 16.7.85, p.24) which amends Council Directive 69/169/EEC (O.J. No. L133, 4.6.69, p.6) in which the duty free allowances are set out.
