The Data Protection Regulations 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 6(7), 8(2) and 40 of the Data Protection Act 1984^(a), and after consultation with the Data Protection Registrar and with the approval of the Treasury, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 11th November 1985.
2. The fee payable under section 6(7) of the Data Protection Act 1984 on an application for registration shall be £22.
3. The initial period of registration and the renewal period under section 8(2) of the Data Protection Act 1984 shall be 3 years.
