House of Commons 4th July 1985**Coming into Operation 23rd October 1985*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the enactments set out in Schedule 1 to this order and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such associations of local authorities as appear to me to be concerned and with the consent of the Treasury, I hereby make the following order:—

Title, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) (No. 3) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on the day after the day on which it is approved by a resolution of the House of Commons.

(2) In this order —

“the 1966 Act” means the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966(a);

“the 1973 Act” means the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(b);

“the 1975 Act” means the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1975(c);

“the 1982 Act” means the Local Government and Planning (Scotland) Act 1982(d);

“the 1984 Act” means the Rating and Valuation (Amendment) (Scotland) Act 1984(e);

“the 1985 Order” means the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) Order 1985(f);
and

“the 1985 No. 2 Order” means the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1985(g).

Redetermined estimated aggregate grants for 1985-86

2. The estimated aggregate amount of the rate support grants for the year 1985-86 (which was fixed as £1,730,300,000 by article 2 of the 1985 No. 2 Order), as redetermined in accordance with the provisions of section 2(2) of the 1966 Act, is hereby fixed and prescribed as £1,603,728,592.

Variation of needs element for 1985-86 and its apportionment

3. The amount of the needs element for the year 1985-86, which was prescribed as £1,424,500,000 by article 2(2) of the 1985 Order, is hereby varied to £1,297,928,592.

4. There shall be apportioned to each local authority set out in column 1 of the table in Schedule 2 to this order the amount of the needs element for the year 1985-86 set out in column 2 of that table opposite to the name of that authority.

Redetermined estimated aggregate grants for 1984-85

5. The estimated aggregate amount of the rate support grants for the year 1984-85 (which was fixed as £1,638,500,000 by article 6 of the 1985 Order), as redetermined in accordance with the provisions of section 2(2) of the 1966 Act, is hereby fixed and prescribed as £1,667,426,220.

Variation of needs element for 1984-85 and its apportionment

6. The amount of the needs element for the year 1984-85, which was varied to £1,409,800,000 by article 7 of the 1985 Order, is hereby further varied to £1,438,726,220.

7. There shall be apportioned to each local authority set out in column 1 of the table in Schedule 3 to this order the amount of the needs element for the year 1984-85 set out in column 2 of that table opposite to the name of that authority which amounts are, in total, £1,436,426,220.

Revocation

8. Article 3 of, and Schedule 2 to, the 1985 Order (which made provision for the apportionment of the needs element for 1985-86) and article 8 of, and Schedule 3 to, that Order (which made provision for the apportionment of the needs element for 1984-85) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order:—

(a) In relation to the year 1985–86:—

- (i) redetermines the estimated aggregate amount of the rate support grants as £1,603,728,592 (previously it was £1,730,300,000) (article 2);
- (ii) varies the amount of the needs element from £1,424,500,000 to £1,297,928,592 (article 3);
- (iii) apportions the needs element as varied to each local authority (article 4 and Schedule 2); and
- (iv) revokes article 3 of, and Schedule 2 to, the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) Order 1985 (article 8).

(b) In relation to the year 1984–85:—

- (i) redetermines the estimated aggregate amount of the rate support grants as £1,667,426,220 (previously it was £1,638,500,000) (article 5);
- (ii) varies the amount of the needs element from £1,409,800,000 to £1,438,726,220 (article 6);
- (iii) apportions the needs element as varied to each local authority (article 7 and Schedule 3); and
- (iv) revokes article 8 of, and Schedule 3 to, the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) Order 1985 (article 8).
