The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 21(1) of the Oil and Gas (Enterprise) Act 1982(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Offshore Installations (Safety Zones) (Revocation) (No. 71) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 10th November 1985.

2. The Offshore Installations (Safety Zones) (No. 63) Order 1985(b) is hereby revoked.
