MERCHANT SHIPPING

**The Merchant Shipping Act 1979 (Commencement No. 9)
Order 1985***Made* - - - 26th November 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 52(2) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979^(a) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1979 (Commencement No.9) Order 1985.

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters specified in the second column to that Schedule) shall come into force on 31st December 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order brings into force section 23(7) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979. That sub-section repeals sections 34–38 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1970 and paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to that Act (which relates to discipline on board ships registered in the United Kingdom).
