The Dental Auxiliaries (Amendment) Regulations 1985

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - - - *26th November 1985*

Coming into Operation *1st December 1985*

Whereas a draft of these regulations, approved by the Privy Council, has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament, pursuant to section 45(9) of the Dentists Act 1984(a).

Now, therefore, the General Dental Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 45 of the Dentists Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dental Auxiliaries (Amendment) Regulations 1985 and shall come into force on 1st December 1985.

2. The Dental Auxiliaries Regulations 1968(b) as amended shall be amended as follows:

For regulation 6 there shall be substituted the following:

“Fees Payable for Enrolments, etc.

6. The following are the fees prescribed by the Council under section 45(7) of the Dentists Act 1984

For the first enrolment of a name	£7
For the retention of a name under regulation 4 of these regulations	£6
For the restoration of a name under regulation 5 of these regulations	£2”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Dental Auxiliaries Regulations 1968, by increasing the fee for first enrolment from £4 to £7; the fee for the retention of a name in a Roll from £3 to £6 and the fee for the restoration of a name from £1 to £2. These fees were last fixed on 1st December 1978.
