CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs)
(Amendment) Order 1985**

Made - - - 10th January 1985

Coming into Operation 11th January 1985

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Customs and Excise Duties (General Reliefs) Act 1979(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 11th January 1985.

2. The Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) Order 1984(b) shall be amended by deleting the word “Greenland” in Part II of Schedule 2 to that Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Customs Duties (ECSC) (Quota and Other Reliefs) Order 1984 by deleting Greenland from the list of developing countries in Schedule 2 which enjoy relief from customs duty in respect of certain iron and steel products. The 1984 Order anticipated that Greenland’s status as part of the European Coal and Steel Community would have been terminated by 1st January 1985, but this has not taken place.
