**The Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (Commencement No. 1) Order
1985**

Made - - - - 5th December 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 143(1) and 157(3) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1985.

2. Section 126 and Schedule 7 and section 156(3) and Schedule 11 in so far as they relate to Schedule 10 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 shall come into operation on 1st January 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order brings into operation on 1st January 1986 the following provisions of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984:—

- (a) Section 126 and Schedule 7 (Restricted Roads); and
- (b) Section 156(3) and Schedule 11 in so far as they relate to Schedule 10 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Speed Limits).

Section 126 and Schedule 7 introduce new means of determining “restricted roads” that is roads to which a 30 m.p.h. speed limit applies automatically. Section 156(3) and Schedule 11 repeal certain transitional provisions and savings in relation to the identification of roads where speed limits are to apply because these provisions are no longer necessary.
