**The Local Government (Interim Provisions) Act 1984  
(Appointed Day) Order 1985**

*Laid before Parliament in draft*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(1) of the Local Government (Interim Provisions) Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following order, a draft of which has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

1. This order may be cited as the Local Government (Interim Provisions) Act 1984 (Appointed Day) Order 1985.
2. The day appointed for the coming into force of Part II of the Local Government (Interim Provisions) Act 1984 is 1st February 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order appoints 1st February 1985 as the day upon which Part II of the Local Government (Interim Provisions) Act 1984 shall come into force.

Part II provides for the suspension of elections to the Greater London Council and the councils of the metropolitan counties and for the extension of the terms of office of existing members. It also empowers the Secretary of State by order to prescribe a quorum for meetings of those councils where he considers it necessary for the transaction of business.
