Regulations 1985**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in relation to England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 54(1) of the New Towns Act 1981^(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the New Town Transfer Schemes (Staff Protection) (Amendment) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

2. In regulation 5 of the New Town Transfer Schemes (Staff Protection) Regulations 1977^(b) for paragraph (a) there shall be substituted—

“(a) be given earlier than a date three months before the date specified in the transfer scheme concerned as the date on which the interest of the new town corporation in the transferred land and any of the corporation’s rights, liabilities and obligations relating to that land are to vest in the district council, and”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend regulation 5 of the New Town Transfer Schemes (Staff Protection) Regulations 1977, which deals with the requirements for a redundancy notice for an employee of a new town corporation or a district council affected by a transfer scheme. This amendment alters the requirement which lays down the earliest date on which the redundancy notice may be given, unless the employee agrees otherwise, to a date not earlier than 3 months before the transfer scheme takes effect.
