**The County of Wiltshire (Miscellaneous Electoral Divisions)
(Electoral Arrangements) Order 1985**

Made - - - - - 4th March 1985

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 2

Whereas in pursuance of section 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 2nd November 1984 submitted proposals for the future electoral arrangements for part of the County of Wiltshire:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 51(2) and 67 of that Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the County of Wiltshire (Miscellaneous Electoral Divisions) (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1985.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 2nd May 1985 except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that day this Order shall come into operation forthwith.

3.— (1) The existing Swindon Toothill and Swindon Western electoral divisions of the County of Wiltshire shall be abolished and the area comprised in those divisions shall be divided into three electoral divisions which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and each such electoral division shall comprise the existing areas specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.

(2) The number of councillors to be elected for each electoral division constituted by this Order shall be one.

4. Where a boundary is described in the Schedule to this Order as running along a road, railway line, footway, waterway or other similar geographical feature, it shall be treated as running along the centre line thereof.

5. The registration officer shall make such re-arrangement or alteration of the register of local government electors as may be necessary on account of the coming into operation of this Order.

Freshbrook	<p><i>In the Borough of Thamesdown</i></p> <p>That part of the Toothill ward bounded by a line commencing at the point where the northwestern boundary of Wroughton electoral division meets the western boundary of the Borough of Thamesdown, thence generally northwestwards and eastwards along that western boundary to Hay Lane, thence southeastwards along that lane to the access road leading to the rectory, thence northeastwards along that access road to its junction with the track leading southeastwards from Wick Farm, thence northeastwards along the path leading from that junction to the northeastern boundary of Parcel No. 1274, as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 microfilm SU 1184, edition A (date of publication 1969), thence generally eastwards along that northeastern boundary and the northern boundary of Parcel No. 3868 to the path leading northeastwards to the unnamed road northwest of the roundabout known as Tewkesbury Cross, thence northeastwards along that path to that unnamed road, thence southeastwards along that road to its junction with Whitehill Way at Tewkesbury Cross, thence southwestwards along the road known as Whitehill Way to the subway forming part of the cycle path running southwards from Whitehill Way to Freshbrook Way, thence southwards along that cycle path, crossing Freshbrook Way, to the western curtilage of No. 7 Rochester Close, thence southeastwards along that western curtilage, the rear curtilages of Nos. 13 to 3 Irston Way, the eastern curtilage of No. 7 King Charles Road and the western curtilage of No. 12 Rochester Close to its southernmost point, thence southeastwards along the field boundary leading from that point to the rear curtilage of No. 15 Ripple Field, thence southeastwards along that rear curtilage and the rear curtilages of Nos. 17 to 19 Ripple Field, thence southeastwards along the field boundary leading from those rear curtilages to the western curtilage of No. 28 Alnwick, thence southwestwards along that western curtilage and the western curtilages of Nos. 27, 24, 23 and 22 Alnwick to the southern corner of the last-mentioned property, thence southwards in a straight line to the western curtilage of No. 21 Alnwick, thence southeastwards along that western curtilage, the rear curtilages of Nos. 18 to 15 Alnwick and the eastern curtilages of Nos. 20 to 21 Edgehill to the southeastern corner of No. 21 Edgehill, thence southwards in a straight line from that corner to the rear curtilage of No. 58 Langdale Drive, thence southeastwards along that curtilage and the rear curtilages of Nos. 56 and 54 Langdale Drive to the easternmost point of the last-mentioned property, thence southeastwards in a straight line from that point to the rear curtilage of No. 50 Langdale Drive, thence southeastwards along</p>
