LEGAL AID AND ADVICE, SCOTLAND

The Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 14A and 15 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967 (a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

(2) In these regulations, the expression “the principal regulations” means the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1973 (b).

2. In Schedule 2 to the principal regulations—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 1, for the sum “£2.00” there shall be substituted the sum “£2.10”;
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 1, for the sums “£13.00”, “£13.00” and “£6.50” there shall be substituted, respectively, the sums “£13.50”, “£13.50” and “£6.75”;
- (c) in sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 1, for the sum “£26” there shall be substituted the sum “£27”;
- (d) in paragraph 2, for the sum “£13” in each place where it occurs there shall be substituted the sum “£15.00”.
