BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

The Gaming Act (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1985

Made	2nd April 1985
Laid before Parliament	18th April 1985
Coming into Operation	27th May 1985

In pursuance of sections 20(8), 31(3) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:-

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming Act (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 27th May 1985.
 - (2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.
- 2. Section 20(8) of the Gaming Act 1968(b) (which specifies the maximum amount by which weekly winnings on any particular bingo club premises may exceed the aggregate amount of the stakes hazarded) shall have effect as if, for the reference to the sum of £1,000, there were substituted a reference to the sum of £1,250.
- 3. Section 31(3) of the Gaming Act 1968(c) (which relates to the charge for playing a game once by means of a machine to which Part III of that Act applies on licensed or registered premises) shall have effect as if, for the reference to the sum of 10p, there were substituted a reference to the sum of 20p.
- 4.—(1) Article 3 of the Gaming Act (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1981(d) (which provides that section 31(3) of the Gaming Act 1968 shall continue to have effect with the substitution of the reference to the sum of 10p for the reference to the sum specified in that subsection) shall be omitted.

(2) In the Schedule to the Gaming Act (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1981 the entry relating to section 20(8) of the Gaming Act 1968 shall be omitted.
