Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 11(3) of the International Transport Conventions Act 1983(a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. It is hereby certified that the 1st May 1985 is the day upon which the Convention comes into force as regards the United Kingdom.

2. This Order may be cited as the International Transport Conventions Act 1983 (Certification of Commencement of Convention) Order 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order certifies the 1st May 1985 as the day upon which the Convention concerning International Carriage by Rail (Cmnd no. 8535) signed on behalf of the United Kingdom on 9th May 1980 comes into force as regards the United Kingdom. By virtue of section 11(3) of the International Transport Conventions Act 1983 section 1 of that Act which gives the force of law to the Convention in the United Kingdom, including the provisions specified in subsection (2) of that section, comes into force on that day.
