**The Central Institutions (Recognition) (Scotland) (No. 2)
Regulations 1985**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 135(1) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Central Institutions (Recognition) (Scotland) (No. 2) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 23rd May 1985.

Recognition as central institutions

2. The educational establishments for the provision of further education named in the Schedule to these regulations shall be and are hereby recognised as central institutions.

Revocation of regulations

3. The Central Institutions (Recognition) (Scotland) Regulations 1985(b) are hereby revoked.
